Let us beseech the Lord that He would do the following for His fresh move in North America:

1. To administrate the world situation from the throne for the move of the great wheel of His economy, to bless the nations of United States and Canada for the sake of His purpose, and to preserve the people and the land for His own will

Psa. 33:12 <u>Blessed is the nation</u> whose God is Jehovah, / <u>The people whom He has chosen</u> as His own possession.

Ezek. 1:15 And as I watched the living creatures, I saw <u>a wheel upon the earth</u> beside the living creatures, for each of their four faces.

Matt. 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole inhabited earth <u>for a testimony</u> to all the nations, and then the end will come.

2. To give godly fear and wisdom to those in high positions of government so that the saints can lead a life in relative peace and tranquility in order to carry out God's desire to save men and to release the truth

Ezra 6:10 That they may offer incense to the God of heaven and <u>pray for the life of the king and his sons</u>. **Jer. 29:7** And <u>seek the peace</u> of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to Jehovah for it; for in its peace you will have peace.

1 Tim. 2:2 On behalf of kings and all who are in high position, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all godliness and gravity.

3. To pour out a spirit of prayer and supplication on the churches in the recovery so they will intercede on behalf of all men according to the desire of the Savior God

1 Tim. 2:1, 3-4 I exhort therefore, first of all, that <u>petitions</u>, <u>prayers</u>, <u>intercessions</u>, <u>thanksgivings be made on behalf of all men</u>; **3.** This is good and acceptable in the sight of our <u>Savior God</u>, <u>4. Who desires</u> all men to be saved and to come to the full knowledge of the truth.

4. To perfect an unprecedented one accord and harmony in coordination, the master key of divine blessings, among the local churches and in the Lord's work

John 17:11, 21, 23 And I am no longer in the world; yet they are in the world, and I am coming to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name, which You have given to Me, that they may be one even as We are. 21. That they all may be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us; that the world may believe that You have sent Me. 23. I in them, and You in Me, that they may be perfected into one, that the world may know that You have sent Me and have loved them even as You have loved Me.

5. To kindle and maintain the spirit of gospel-preaching in all the saints so they can be witnesses of Christ to proclaim the complete and high gospel of God to the unbelievers

Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and <u>you shall be My witnesses</u> both in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Eph. 6:15 And having shod your feet with the firm foundation of the gospel of peace;

Eph. 6:19 And for me, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known in boldness the mystery of the gospel, **20** For which I am an ambassador in a chain, that in it I would speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Phil. 1:27 Only, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of <u>the gospel of Christ</u>, that whether coming and seeing you or being absent, I may hear of the things concerning you, that you stand firm in one spirit, with one soul striving together *along* with the faith of the gospel,

- 6. To open a door for the Word of God, especially the interpreted word, the deeper truths, and the ministry of the age in the hearts of numerous seeking believers and Christian groups
 - **Col. 4:3** Praying at the same time for us also, that <u>God would open to us a door for the word</u>, to speak the mystery of Christ (because of which also I am bound),
 - **2 Thes. 3:1** Finally, brothers, pray concerning us, that the word of the Lord may run and be glorified, even as it is also with you;
 - **Acts 17:11** Now these people were more noble than those in Thessalonica, for <u>they received the word with all eagerness</u>, <u>examining the Scriptures daily</u> *to see* whether these things were so.
- 7. To recover and sustain a common practice of migration in the churches and in the saints, that they would live a life of the altar and the tent and move to spread the Lord's testimony to many places
 - **Acts 8:4** Those therefore who were scattered went throughout the land announcing the word as the gospel. **Acts 11:19** Those then who were scattered by the tribulation which took place on account of Stephen passed
 - through as far as Phoenicia and Cyprus and Antioch, speaking the word to no one except Jews only. **Heb. 11:13** All these died in faith, not receiving the promises but seeing them from afar and joyfully greeting *them* and confessing that they were strangers and <u>sojourners on the earth</u>.
- 8. To plant golden church-tree lampstands, through the migrating saints in many new cities and towns in every state and province
 - **Acts 9:31** So then the church throughout the whole of Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it was multiplied.
 - **Gal. 1:2** And all the brothers who are with me, to the churches of Galatia:
 - **Rev. 1:11** Saying, What you see write in a scroll and send *it* to the seven churches: to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamos and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea.
- 9. To silence and turn the opposers and critics of the recovery and the ministry by opening/enlightening their inner eyes and by granting them a just heart and fair discernment of the facts and the truth
 - **1 Tim. 1:16** But because of this I was shown mercy, that in me, the foremost, Jesus Christ might display all His long-suffering for a pattern to those who are to believe on Him unto eternal life.
 - **2 Tim. 2:25** In meekness <u>correcting those who oppose</u>, if perhaps God may give them repentance unto the full knowledge of the truth,
 - **2 Tim. 3:9** But they will not advance farther, for their folly will be completely manifest to all, as also the *folly* of those became.
- 10. To increase the number of typical Americans in the churches--to make the membership in the recovery more proportionate to the ethnic demographics of the general population--while still gaining people of every tribe, tongue, and nation for the one new man
 - **Col. 3:10-11** And have <u>put on the new man</u>, which is being renewed unto full knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, **11** Where <u>there cannot be</u> Greek and Jew, circumcision and uncircumcision, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free man, but Christ is all and in all.
 - **Rev. 5:9** And they sing a new song, saying: You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, for You were slain and have purchased for God by Your blood <u>men</u> out of every tribe and tongue and people and <u>nation</u>,
- 11. To gain an unprecedented number of college and high school students through a prevailing labor on the campuses with students spear-heading and full-timers and families supporting the work
 - **Psa. 110:3** Your people will offer themselves willingly / In the day of Your warfare, / In the splendor of their consecration. / <u>Your young men will be to You</u> / Like the dew from the womb of the dawn.
 - **Matt. 4:19-20** And He said to them, Come after Me, and <u>I will make you fishers of men</u>. **20** And immediately leaving the nets, they followed Him.

1 Tim. 4:12 Let no one despise your youth, but be a pattern to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.

12. To thrust out continuous contingents of workers, full-time serving ones of all ages, into the Lord's harvest to gather fruit and bring in the sheaves here and worldwide

Psa. 126:6 He who goes forth and weeps, / Bearing seed for scattering, / Will no doubt come in with a ringing shout, / Bearing his sheaves with him.

Luke 10:2 And He said to them, The harvest is great, but the workers few; therefore, beseech the Lord of the harvest that He would <u>thrust out workers into His harvest</u>.

John 4:38 I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labor.

13. To raise up the next generation of serving saints, the young adults, by increasing their enrollment in the full-time training and by perfecting them to be normal, vital, and overcoming ones to be as pillars in the churches

Rom. 12:11 Do not be slothful in zeal, *but* be burning in spirit, serving the Lord.

Eph. 4:12 For the perfecting of the saints unto the work of the ministry, unto the building up of the Body of Christ,

Rev. 3:12 He who overcomes, him I will make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall by no means go out anymore, and I will write upon him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which descends out of heaven from My God, and My new name

14. To work out the New Testament priesthood of the gospel and the practice of the God-ordained way of every member begetting, nourishing, perfecting, and prophesying for the building up of the Body

John 15:16 You did not choose Me, but I chose you, and I set you that you should go forth and bear fruit and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name, He may give you.

John 21:15 Then when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, Simon, *son* of John, do you love Me more than these? He said to Him, Yes, Lord, You know that I love You. He said to him, Feed My lambs.

Rom. 15:16 That I might be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, a laboring priest of the gospel of God, in order that the offering of the Gentiles might be acceptable, having been sanctified in the Holy Spirit.

- 15. To empower the saints to stand against the schemes of Satan, the stratagems of the devil, and the work of the enemy, and to defeat the rulers of darkness and forces of evil in the heavenlies that opposes God's move on the earth
 - **2 Cor. 2:11** That we may not be taken advantage of by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes.
 - **Eph. 6:10** Finally, be empowered in the Lord and in the might of His strength.
 - Eph. 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God that you may be able to stand against the stratagems of the devil,
 - **Eph. 6:12** For our wrestling is not against blood and flesh but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the world-rulers of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of evil in the heavenlies.
- 16. To answer the petitions, prayers, and intercessions of the saints for North America so that God's name may be sanctified, His kingdom may come, and His will may be done on earth as it is in heaven

1 Tim. 2:1 I exhort therefore, first of all, that <u>petitions</u>, <u>prayers</u>, <u>intercessions</u>, <u>thanksgivings be made</u> on behalf of all men;

Matt. 6:9-10 You then <u>pray in this way</u>: Our Father who is in the heavens, Your name be sanctified; Your kingdom come; Your will be done, as in heaven, *so* also on earth.
